Auckland, New Zealand - Kiwi Chic...although Auckland is a small harbour city, it has over the years turned into a sophisticated and cultured metropolis. Lying between two blue harbours and dotted with the cones of old volcanos the city boasts a great mix of natural and historic sites.



Tauranga, New Zealand - On the west side of the Bay of Plenty is the town of Tauranga. Its Maori name means "sheltered anchorage" - referring to its natural harbour enclosed by the long, narrow island of Matakana. The Bay of Plenty originated with James Cook during his 1769-70 exploration of New Zealand. It's a large indentation situated around a body of water incorporating several large islands. Not far away is Rotorua, which is known for its geothermal activity, geysers and hot mud pools.

Christchurch, New Zealand - Close to the magnificent Dorset World Heritage Coast and the tranquil New Forest National Park, Christchurch is a diverse mix of fascinating heritage, beautiful coastline and countryside. It is considered the most English city downunder and is known as the "garden city" - example being Mona Vale, a historic homestead surrounded by stunning landscaped gardens. It is a place of history, colour and atmosphere.



Dunedin, New Zealand - A city nestled in tree-clad hills at the head of a spectacular harbour, Dunedin is New Zealand's largest city by area and arguably the most spectacular in terms of contrasting landscapes. Home to an arty crowd, the city is considered to be the country's arts centre. It's compact town is a comfortable blend of historic and contemporary reflected in its alluring museums, tempting cafes and restaurants. The country's oldest university provides a wonderful energy.

Fiordland, New Zealand - A raw wilderness with jagged mountains dropping into the lakes, Fiordland is breathtaking, remote and wondrous. The power of the scenery never fails to enthrall - waterfalls tumble hundreds of metres into massive fiords; ancient rainforest clings impossibly to the mountains; shimmering lakes and granite peaks all like today, as they did thousands of years ago.

Hobart, Tasmania, Australia - Australia's second-oldest city, Hobart lies in the foothills of Mt. Wellington. The town's rich colonial heritage and natural charms are accented by a spirited atmosphere. 19th-century waterfront warehouses dating back to the 1830's whaling days mingle with cafes, restaurants and art studios. Bonorong Wildlife Sanctuary is dedicated to helping the native wildlife survive. This is a great place to see the Tasmanian Devil, the Eastern Quail, The Tasmanian Pademelon and the shy Tasmanian Bettong - all species, sadly, now extinct everywhere but in Tasmania.



Melbourne, Australia - Sophisticated and slick, Melbourne is a beautiful city with ornate Victorian-era architecture, leafy boulevards and urban hip. It is the closest thing to a European-style city in Australia and the scene revolves around its two waterfronts. Outside of the city is the Yarra Valley, renowned for its beauty, wineries, national parks, forests and mountains - a wonderful place to visit and lunch at a vineyard.

Sydney, Australia - Australia's oldest, largest and most diverse city, Sydney is world renowned for its harbour; Opera House on one side and the Sydney Bridge on the other. But there is more to Sydney. Walk up its hills and well past Sydney Harbour and you will find quaint neighbourhoods. Pockets of European history, Aboriginal history and Asian influences abound.
