**Cusco, Peru** - Once capital of the Inca Empire, it is known as the archaeological capital of Peru; beautiful churches, museums, ruins, red-tiled roofs, colonial buildings and cobblestone streets.

**Machu Picchu, Peru** - The first question inevitably asked by visitors is: "How did this city of more than 200 structures, built 2,000 feet above the valley of Rio Urubamba - the sacred river of the Inca - get there?" The answer is a testament to the skills and ingenuity of the Inca builders. Perched atop a mountain spur covered with lush vegetation overlooking the Rio Urubamba Valley, it is a tranquil place filled with beauty and enchantment. As a 'New7Wonders', truly magical, mystical and spiritual, Machu Picchu should be viewed at glorious dawn or dramatic dusk when you can (almost) feel the presence of the worshipers of the Inca Sun God.



**Santiago, Chile** - Basking in a beautiful setting with the snow-capped Andes as a backdrop and desert-type landscape, Santiago is cultured, quirky and a bit more upscale than other South American cities. Wonderful neighbourhoods present tree-lined streets, artistic enclaves, cafes and lovely colonial architecture.



**Punta Arenas, Chile** - Located on the Strait of Magellan, Punta Arenas is a settlement home to fisherman, Chilean Air Force and adventure travellers. About an hour away is Otway Penguin Colony, one of the homes to the Magellan Penguins which is a site to see - they are comical and cute.

**Chilean Fjords and Cape Horn** - Stunningly beautiful, the Chilean Fjords are remote and pristine. Sailing through this southern part of Chile gives you a front-row view of towering, crystalized

glaciers and an abundance of marine wildlife. Cape Horn is the most southerly point of South America - for many years it was the major milestone of the clipper route by which sailing ships carried trade around the world.



**Ushuaia, Argentina** - Considered the southernmost city in the world, Ushuaia is a lovely port town surrounded by mountains, glaciers, forests and the Beagle Channel. Inside Tierra del Fuego is Lapataia Bay which is known as one of the most southern pieces of land before Antarctica.

**Stanley, Falkland Islands** - The Falkland Islands are one of the last untouched wildlife wonders in the world. Unspoilt beaches, islands and cliffs provide a natural safe-haven for hundreds of species. There is also a rich military history.



**Buenos Aires, Argentina** - What can we say about Buenos Aires other than we love this city. It is vibrant, architecturally beautiful and you never get bored. Buenos Aires offers a combination of European sophistication and South American Latin rhythm.

**Montevideo, Uruguay** - Montevideo is an eclectic city with old, well-preserved buildings, wide avenues, green parks and a rich cultural life. The city has been shaped by its rural character but now, art-deco buildings in

the historical centre jostle with more modern architecture.

**Rio de Janeiro, Brazil** - Considered, visually, one of the most beautiful cities in the world, Rio de Janeiro is an exhilarating city flanked with gorgeous mountains, white-sand beaches and verdant rainforests fronting the deep blue sea. It's an intoxicating tropical cocktail of beauty and samba-rhythm locals.

Cusco is approximately 3,400 metres (11,200 feet) above sea level. Machu Picchu is approximately 2,430 metres (7,970 feet) above sea level. Although we have incorporated a rest period upon arrival in Cusco to assist in acclimatizing, you may want to visit your doctor to discuss altitude medication .There will be some walking and even light climbing at the ruins. Program may change slightly due to situations beyond our control. Hotels are as indicated or similar.
